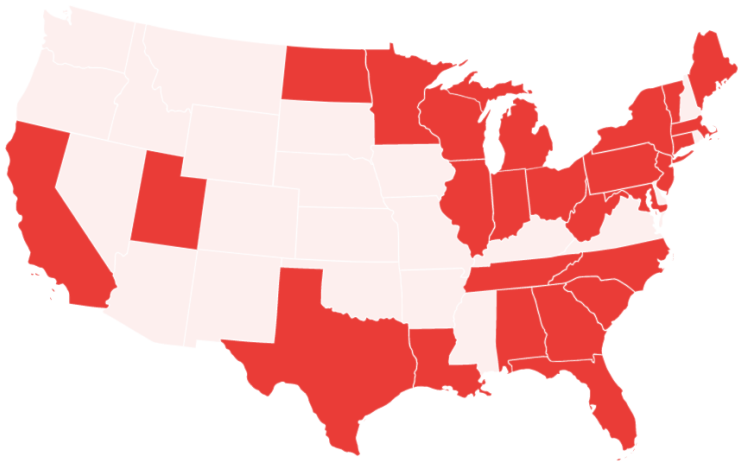

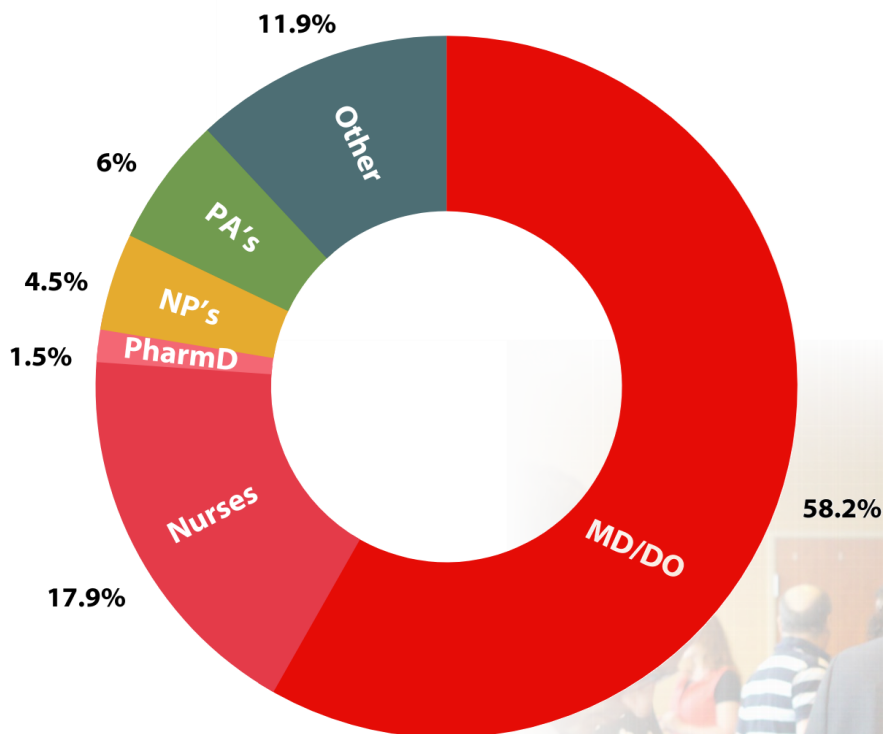

Booth Assignment

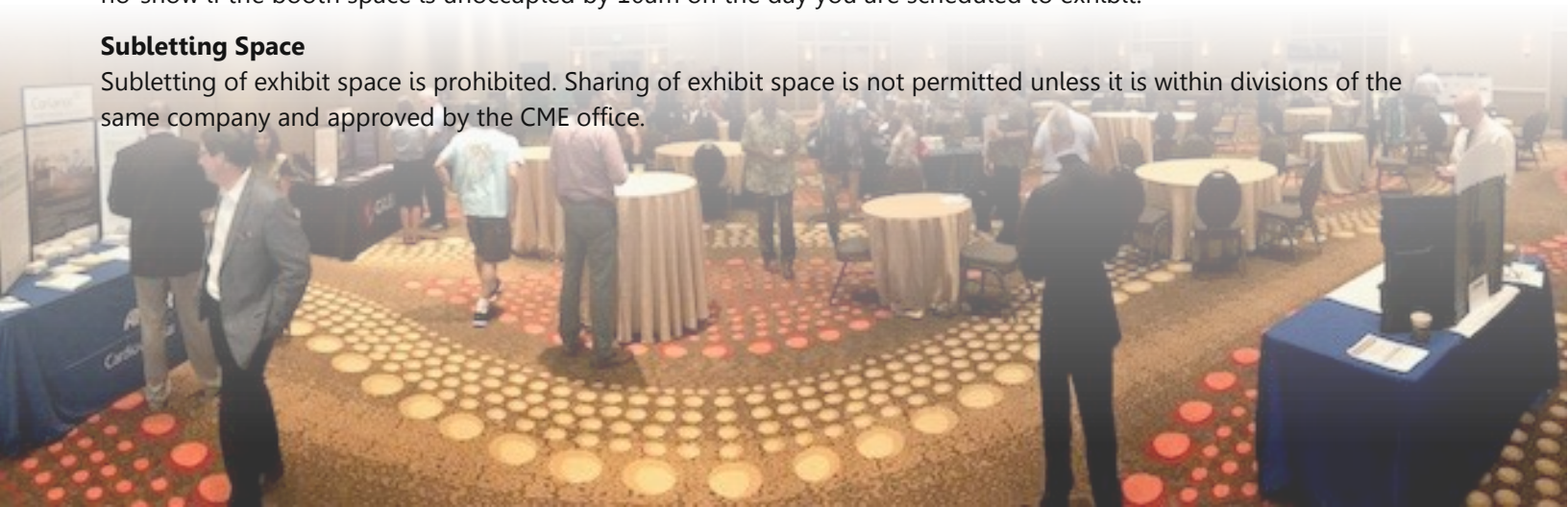
Booths will be assigned at the discretion of the CME office. Preference will be given to high level sponsors.
